

Meridian room-correction

Meridian Audio has announced a significant upgrade to its flagship digital processor, the 861. Version 4 software, coupled with the new EF20 DSP Card, includes Meridian Room Correction.

The system is said to be able to control room modes at low frequencies, where problems are most noticeable. The company claims effective results can be obtained for a broad range of

listening positions. The feature uses Meridian's on-board DSP to first measure the room and then automatically build a series of digital filters that reduce reverberation for significant room modes. As the filters are entirely digital they can be created without any artefacts and incorporated into the all-digital Meridian signal path. Meridian claims that the result is a very noticeable

improvement in the sound of a room, calming down resonance and smoothing out the overall acoustic behaviour.

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
