

# Meridian adds DAB to G Series

Meridian has added DAB Digital Radio capability as an option to its well-received G Series line-up, with new G01, G51 and G91 variants. In the G51DAB receiver and G01DAB controller (Meridian's term for a pre-amplifier), and the G91DAB DVD-Audio/video player/controller, a DAB/FM tuner section replaces the AM/FM tuner section of the standard models. Any of these models will now provide the user with the benefits of DAB, including easy access to a wide range of stations by name, virtually no background noise or interference and on-screen information including station name, music genre and other data. DAB reception capability is completely and seamlessly integrated into the system. For DAB, the default display mode gives

a short (eight character) version of the station name; corner indicators show when the tuner is in DAB mode and the data-rate of the stream, plus whether it is stereo or mono and the preset number, if any. Up and down soft-keys allow the user to display the names of available stations in alphabetical order. Additional levels of information can be obtained by successively pressing the 'Display' button to show: the ensemble name (scrolls); RadioText (up to 128 scrolling characters); programme type (genre); and via a series of



Meridian-specified screens, back to the main display. UK suggested retail prices are £1725 for the G01DAB, £2350 for the G51DAB and £4250 for the G91DAB controller.
